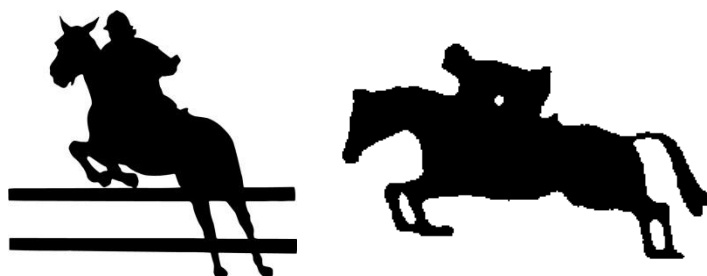

3. **You must Pre Enter for ALL classes before the closing date.** If time allows, additional entries on the field may be accepted at £2 extra per class but only if you have pre-entered at least one class before the closing date..
4. **CLOSING DATE -Wednesday 12th July 2017 at midnight**

7. This show is open to both Riding Club members and non RC members aged 18+ (see rule 7)

Other Information

1. Please note **NO DOGS ALLOWED** whatsoever, this is a specific request from venue owners, please respect their wishes.
2. Entry from Gilmerton Entrance - Parking at entrance to show field before Show Jumping Ring (where toilets are normally situated)
3. Lothians Members Points Show Jumping Only. Members points 1st to 6th place. No members points for Class 4 .
4. **Class 1 is for genuine novice horses** - this class is designed as an introduction for horses to a working hunter class. Entries for this class will be monitored.
5. **Class 4 is for genuine novice horses and/or riders only** and you cannot compete in Classes 7 and upwards.

Rules for Jumping Shows 2017

Please read these rules carefully

Health & Safety Rules

1. Lothians Riding Club, the organising committee, the owners of the show ground or any agent acting on their behalf cannot be held responsible or accept any liability for loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, ponies, riders, owners, grooms, ground spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.
2. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organiser and all officials and stewards.
3. **All riders when riding, whether competing or not, must wear hard hats, with strap properly adjusted and fastened and only the following specifications are acceptable at any BRC competition**

BRITISH & EUROPEAN	British PAS 015: 1998 or 2011 VG1 01.040: 2014-12	and must have BSI Kitemark and must have BSI Kitemark	
AMERICAN	ASTM F1163: 2004a or 04a onwards SNELL E2001	and must have SEI marked SNELL 2001 and must have official SNELL label & number	
AUSTRALIA AND NEW ZEALAND	AS/NZS 3838: 2006 onwards	and must have SAI Global mark	

All hats which only meet the standard EN1384 or BSEN1384, and do not comply with another standard from the above list, WILL NOT be accepted and therefore will not be permitted for any BRC competition. Hats which bear EN1384 or BSEN1384 **along with** another standard from the above list are acceptable. For example, BSEN1384 & PAS015 (1998 or 2011) along with the Kitemark, would be acceptable, but not BSEN1384 on its own. *Any rider found to be using a hat to a lower standard will be disqualified*

4. Body Protectors are not mandatory, however if you wish to wear one, we suggest that body protectors should be a BETA Level 3 (purple label) which has been manufactured in the year 2000 or after.
5. Riders must wear correct footwear and be smartly dressed and if possible wear a smart jacket.
6. Riders who fall off during the competition must be deemed fit to continue riding and if they wish to do so they do it entirely at their own risk.
7. **All riders must be 18 years and over. Be a member of a Riding Club (not necessarily LRC) or hold your own 3rd Party insurance cover.** 18 year olds must provide proof of age if required.
8. All horses to be 4 years and over and 14.2hh and over. Passport maybe checked for height verification.
9. Canterng allowed ONLY in the practice and competition areas
10. **Horses and Riders MUST REMOVE ANY RUGS BEFORE THEY ENTER THE ARENA.** Lothian's Riding Club officials are not responsible for removing rugs from horses entering the arena.

Additional Rules

11. Lothian's Riding Club members will receive league table points. Points allocated from 1st to 6th place. Show Jumping Points will only be awarded for the first two classes members enter. To qualify for Points your Membership must be fully paid up in advance of any show, those who rejoin or join at a show are not able to qualify for the points at that show.
12. **Entry for at least one class must be made in advance to be eligible to enter additional classes on the day.** All classes must be **paid for in advance** of the class and **entry fees only refunded** if the show is cancelled or the classes are full. Lothians Riding Club reserves the right to cancel a show if insufficient pre-entries are received.
13. Lothian's Riding Club reserves the right to refuse entries and classes must be entered prior to start of class. No entries will be taken once a class has started. Classes will not be held up to wait for competitors arriving late or who are not ready to compete at the correct time.
14. Riders competing in the first class are not eligible to compete in the last class (unless on a different horse).
15. In view of fairness please do not enter classes competitively that you are not eligible for, HC entries are acceptable. HC Entries do not qualify for members points.
16. The Judges decision is final. Any complaints to be made in writing to the secretary and accompanied by £20. The complaint must be made within one hour of the incidence.
17. BHS Riding Club Rules apply to the show.
18. Please take your rubbish home with you and leave the venue tidy.
