- Rosettes and Members points 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> place. No members points for Class 1.
- Class 1 is for genuine novice horses and/or riders only** and you cannot compete in Classes 4 and upwards.
- You must Pre Enter for ALL classes before the closing date.** If time allows, additional entries on the field may be accepted at £2 extra per class.
- Competitors will be put into timed groups for each class and approximate time for that class will be published on the website or emailed by Friday 25<sup>th</sup> May 2018. E.g. Class 1 - Group 1 4pm-4.15pm, Class 1 Group 2 4.15pm-4.30pm etc
- Closing Date is Wednesday 23rd May 2018**

# Lothian's Riding Club

## Rules for Jumping Shows 2018

**Please read these rules carefully**

### **Health & Safety Rules**

1. Lothians Riding Club, the organising committee, the owners of the show ground or any agent acting on their behalf cannot be held responsible or accept any liability for loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, ponies, riders, owners, grooms, ground spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.
2. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organiser and all officials and stewards.
3. **All riders when riding, whether competing or not, must wear hard hats, with strap properly adjusted and fastened and in accordance with the standards indicated on British Riding Clubs website. Links can be found on Lothians website. Any rider found to be wearing a hat to a lower specification will be disqualified.**
4. Body Protectors are not mandatory, however if you wish to wear one, we suggest that body protectors should be a BETA Level 3 (purple label) which has been manufactured in the year 2009 or after.
5. Riders must wear correct footwear and be smartly dressed and if possible wear a smart jacket.
6. Riders who fall off during the competition must be deemed fit to continue riding and if they wish to do so they do it entirely at their own risk.
7. **All riders must be 18 years and over. Be a member of a Riding Club (not necessarily LRC) or hold your own 3<sup>rd</sup> Party insurance cover. Insurance Policy details must be provided from on entry form** 18 year olds must provide proof of age if required.
8. All horses to be 4 years and over and 14.3hh and over. Passport maybe checked for height verification.
9. Canter allowed ONLY in the practice and competition areas
10. Horses and Riders MUST REMOVE ANY RUGS BEFORE THEY ENTER THE ARENA. Lothian's Riding Club officials are not responsible for removing rugs from horses entering the arena.

### **Additional Rules**

11. Lothian's Riding Club members will receive league table points. Points allocated from 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> place. Show Jumping Points will only be awarded for the first two classes members enter. To qualify for Points your Membership must be fully paid up in advance of any show, those who rejoin or join at a show are not able to qualify for the points at that show.
12. **Entry for at least one class must be made in advance to be eligible to enter additional classes on the day.** All classes must be **paid for in advance** of the class and **entry fees only refunded** if the show is cancelled or the classes are full. Lothians Riding Club reserves the right to cancel a show if insufficient pre-entries are received.
13. Lothian's Riding Club reserves the right to refuse entries and classes must be entered prior to start of class. No entries will be taken once a class has started. Classes will not be held up to wait for competitors arriving late or who are not ready to compete at the correct time.
14. Riders competing in the first class are not eligible to compete in the last class (unless on a different horse).
15. In view of fairness please do not enter classes competitively that you are not eligible for, HC entries are acceptable. HC Entries do not qualify for members points.
16. The Judges decision is final. Any complaints to be made in writing to the secretary and accompanied by £20. The complaint must be made within one hour of the incidence.
17. BHS Riding Club Rules apply to the show.
18. Please take your rubbish home with you and leave the venue tidy.
