2. **PRELIM ENTRIES FOR AREA QUALIFIERS** – All preliminary entries (teams and individuals) for Novice and Intermediate Qualifier classes must be made through your Riding Club. **These prelim entries MUST BE MADE NO LATER THAN FRIDAY 13th OCTOBER 2017.**

5. **Flu Vaccinations**

Up to date Flu Vaccination records are mandatory for all Qualifiers and Championships. A copy of the current database for each club will be emailed to Club Secretaries before Prelim Entry Deadline.

- a) **Horses already on Database** – please check vaccinations records on database are up to date and if not scan and email passport (name page and recent vaccination page)
- b) **Horses not on the Database** – please scan and email passport (name page, all vaccination pages and horse drawing page)

TEAM MANAGER / COMPETITOR NOTES

- Competition will start at approximately 8.30am.
- All competitors jump two rounds. If a team member is eliminated in the first round they are permitted to compete in the second round, however individuals eliminated in the first round are not permitted to compete in the second round. All rounds will be timed. The times for the second round are used to determine minor placings when faults cannot do this. If there is equality for first place after the second round there will be a jump off around a course, which may be shortened and raised at the discretion of the judge and the official steward against the clock. For teams the best three scores in each round will count for the total score.
- All classes will be in drawn order and Start Times will be available online on the evening of Thursday 2nd November 2017 online at: www.brcaarea1.co.uk
- It is the responsibility of each competitor to ensure their horse vaccination record meets BRC rules and that they are eligible for classes entered. Eligibility of riders and horses, Rules are in the BRC rule book (online version available via BRC and BRC Area 1 website).
- All communication between the Secretary and Competitors must be done through the Team Manager and not the competitors themselves.
- In the unlikely event of bad weather, a percentage of the entry fee will be retained to cover admin and arena hire costs.
- Please note all Championship Invitations are issued by BRC Head Office, as all results require to be verified.

ON THE DAY

- **Riding Club Membership Cards** must be shown to the secretary on the day.
- **Horse/Pony Passports** must be shown to the secretary on the day (*note these may be kept until later in the afternoon to check against database*).
- **Declaration Forms** – It is the responsibility of the Team Manager / Chef d'Equipe to fill out the declaration forms and must be fully completed and handed to the secretary on the day.
- **The Team Manager / Chef d'Equipe** should take Declaration Form(s), Passports and Riding Club membership cards to the secretary's office when they go and declare.
- **Competition Numbers:** Once the declaration forms are received then the competitors will receive the competition numbers for the day.
- **Communication with Secretary:** All communication with the Secretary must be done solely through the Team Manager.
- **Hats:** All hats must have a visible orange BRC hat tag in place before they are used for warming up and competing, to show that it meets the current safety standards. There will be a trained official available on the day at the secretary's office to do this for you if your hat does not currently have one.
- **Photography:** There will be a photographer on site.
- **Caterer & Toilets** on site.
- **Farrier:** There will not be a farrier on site.
- **Vets:** On Call Cover.
- **Medical Cover:** Jim Barclay
- **Objections:** Protests or complaints may be lodged in writing and handed into the Event Secretary. The protest must be accompanied by a deposit of £20.00. They must be made no later than 30 minutes after the incident that gave rise to that protest, or 30 minutes after the results have been published. The deposit will be forfeited unless the protest is upheld or it was decided there were good and reasonable grounds for lodging the protest.
